Fr. Colin Wen, one of five children of Gerard and Annette Wen, was born and raised in Palo Alto, California, where his parents still reside. He received his BA in Sociology from UC Davis in 2005, before volunteering for a year in the impoverished area of Los Angeles known as Skid Row. During this time he began discerning a call to the priesthood and, after returning to the Diocese of Sacramento, he entered St. Patrick's Seminary in 2006, where he spent his first two years of pre-theology. He was ordained in 2013 and served briefly in Grass Valley, Nevada City, Downieville, and Dixon. For the last three years, he has served as parochial vicar at St. Vincent Ferrer Parish in Vallejo.
